



Volunteer info for Camarillo Marathon Jan 8, 2012 race day time line.

General info:

- **Race Director info:** Bill Escobar 805-258-3779, Laura Escobar 805-258-2288
- Look for the Volunteer tent and banner when you arrive and check in.
- Please make sure you bring your cell phone with you on race day.
- Allow for traffic congestion in the morning, we have hundreds of people all trying to get to the same area at once.
- Bring a jacket and bring sun block, hat, sun glasses, the weather is unpredictable so we want you to be comfortable during the race
- Please be aware of all traffic during the event, we will have signs and cones on the road but you should still be careful at all times.

Race day Sunday January 8, 2012

5:00a.m. to 8:00 a.m. (12 volunteers needed)

Race course set up team should arrive on site and help out with directional signs And aid station supplies drop off. We would like three teams of 4 volunteers each. We would also need 3 people that have trucks or SUV to help drop off the aid station supplies along the race course, table, water, cups, canopy.

5:30 a.m. – 8:30 a.m. (10 needed)

Volunteers for Race Day check in should arrive at this time and be ready to help with athlete check in process that starts at 5:45 a.m. and ends at 6:45 a.m.

6:15 a.m. to: 2:30 p.m. (102 needed, 6 persons per aid station 17 aid stations)

All aid station and intersection volunteers should be on site at this time. Please make sure to check in with Bill, Laura, or Larissa Escobar and then report to your pre assigned station. If you have not been assigned to an area please make sure you mention that right away. Bill Escobar – 805-258-3779, Laura Escobar – 805-258-2288, Larissa Escobar- 805-258-1633



6:45 a.m.

Aid stations should be filled with volunteers and volunteers should be pre-pouring water into cups for runners that will be coming your way. Other volunteers should get trash bags ready to clean up the empty cups that runners will be tossing along the path as they pass. Please do your best to get all the cups that runners toss on the road.

6:45 a.m.

All aid station captains should text or call Bill Escobar and check in to make sure we have all station covered and ready to go before the race starts. All intersection volunteers (two person teams) should be in place and text Race Director to confirm their position and ready to go.

7:00 a.m. full marathon starts

Race start gun goes off. All runners will be looking to volunteers for water, Gatorade sports drink, and in some cases directions. Please make sure you keep your eyes out for approaching runners at all times.

9:15 a.m.

Check your watches.... Use a rule of thumb of about 15 to 18 minutes per mile for some walkers and you will get an idea of when the last athlete passes your station. We will have a designated last person for you to look for.

When the last runner has passed your station please text or call the race director so that we know what the flow of runners is doing on race day.

Once the last runner passes your station please clean up your area and call for a ride back to the race site if needed. Please do your best to get all race day trash off the roadway and fields that may have been left by the athletes. If you drove your own car to the aid station location please make sure you bring any and all trash bags with you and place them in the event dumpster near the expo. Please make sure you check in with the race director to see if you are needed for any other race activities. If you have to leave at a certain time please remind the race director of that as well.



Finish line team: (10 needed)

Give each runner a, finisher medal bottle of water and congratulations. Please alert the first aid personnel of anyone that looks like they are in trouble.

Clean up team:

12:00 to 3:00 pm (15 people needed please arrive no later than Noon)

Team #1 will consist of 4 people that will drive the course and look for any cups, gae packs, or other race day trash that needs to be picked up and brought back to the race site. Come back to the finish line / expo area to drop off your supplies and help with any other post race clean up.

Team#2 Pick up the water station tables and any leftover supplies that might still be there. Come back to the finish line / expo area to drop off your supplies and help with any other post race clean up.
